



PASSPORT INFORMATION

FROM THE OFFICE OF SENATOR MARKWAYNE MULLIN

- **Check your passport expiration dates and plan accordingly**
 - Some countries require that your passport be valid for at least six months beyond the date of your trip
 - Airlines are liable to turn you away if your passport expires less than the allotted time for which the country requires
- **Apply as soon as possible**
 - 4-6 months in advance of your travel is preferable.
 - If you are less than 6 months from your travel date, pay the expedite fee.
- **Send all passport applications via trackable mail**
 - Pay for the 1-2 day delivery for the return of your new passport
- **Processing times for passports are:**
 - 8-11 weeks for routine processing (meaning no expedited fees were paid)
 - 5-7 weeks for an expedited passport.
 - Be aware that as summer approaches processing times may be extended
- **Check the status of your passport at passportstatus.state.gov**
 - It is the easiest and fastest way to know where your passport is in the process.
 - It may take up to two weeks before your application shows “In Process”
